How to Load and Calibrate SM-CM Product on the SM4 PLUS Printer




Important: The Cutter is not used when printing on SM-CM Product


1. Open the **Printer Access Cover.**




2. Turn the green **Print Head Latch** to the right to unlock and open the print head.




3. Unlock then slide the Primary Guide away from the print head. See Figure 1



4. Next, slide the sensor out that is under the print head using the green handle. See Figure 2



- 5. Route the SM-CM Product through the printer as follows:
 - a. Guide the product between the back guide (1) then under the middle guide (2). Next, place it in-between the Primary Guide fingers (3). The side with the liner should be facing on the inside. See *Figure 3*




b. Using the red knob, adjust the red guide fingers until they are in close proximity to the product on each side.

Important: The SM-CM product should move freely in the guides.

6. Slide the SM-CM product in-between the sensor so that the imprinted triangle on the sensor arm is directly over the opening in the middle of the product. See Figure 4

NOTE: The imprinted triangle may be difficult to see, so using a light source to view it may be the best option.



- 7. With the SM-CM Product in position, close down and lock the print head.
- 8. To turn off the Cutter on the physical printer, go to the front panel and tap the

MENU icon then select **SETTING**. Tap on **PRINT MODE** then change it to **NONE**. Return to the main screen.

- 9. On the front panel, tap the **MENU** icon then select **SENSOR** on **AUTO CALIBRATION** then select **GAP**. The printer will calibrate and feed out approximately 2-5 markers then stop.
- 10. Your SM-CM Product is now calibrated on the printer and is ready for printing.

 IMPORTANT! The product will need to be re-calibrated after each print job!
